AMENDMENT TO THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ORDINANCE

Whereas, it has come to the attention of the Oconee County Board of Commissioners that certain age requirements in the Alcoholic Beverages Ordinance are causing an unnecessary hardship on owners of restaurants; and

Whereas, such changes will not unduly affect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Oconee County;

Now therefore, the Oconee County Board of Commissioners does hereby ordain as follows:

Article 1: Section 4(A)(1) of the Alcoholic Beverages Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

“No license defined herein shall be issued to a person who is not a legal resident of the United States and at least 21 years of age.”

Article 2: Section 5(A) of the Alcoholic Beverages Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Employment and supervision of underage persons. It shall be unlawful for any person to allow or require a person in his employment less than eighteen years of age or the minimum age designated by law, whichever is greater, to dispense, serve, sell or take orders for any alcoholic beverages. Alcoholic beverages may not be sold by any licensee hereunder unless there is on duty at the licensed location at the time of such sale a person of at least 21 years of age who is in charge of that location at that time. Such on duty personnel shall be present at the premises except for job related absences not exceeding one hour.”


Article 3: It is intended that the provisions of this amendment be severable and should any portion be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other portion of this Amendment.

Article 4: All resolutions or ordinances and parts of sections of resolutions or ordinances in conflict with this Amendment are hereby repealed.


